



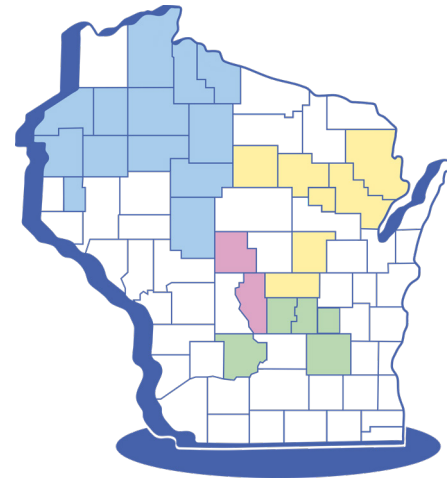
# COLLABORATION OF WISCONSIN RURAL INVESTMENT (COW)
